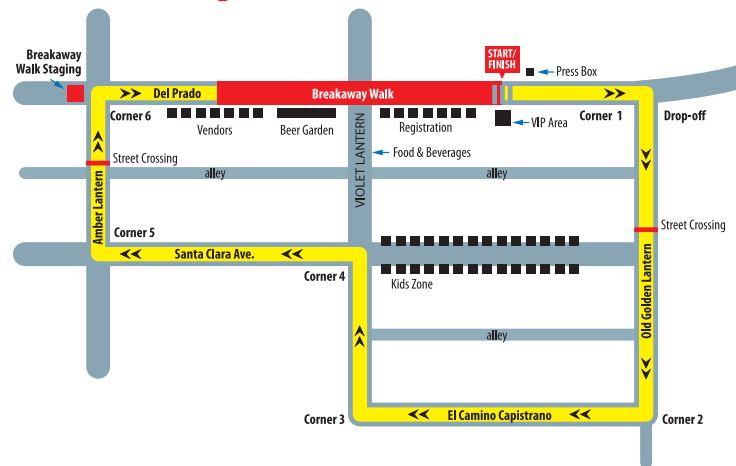
There will be something for everyone!
